DIVORCE RECORDS

The court began sending divorces for recording in the Official Records in 1974. Generally, only the final judgment is of record here. Microfilm of the settlement agreement may be available at the Archives Division of the Clerk's office. Earlier divorce records may also be obtained there.

MARRIAGE RECORDS

You may obtain a certified copy of any marriage license that has been issued by the Broward County Clerk of Courts from 1915 thru the present.

Cost of the copies is \$4.00 for the first copy and \$2.50 for each additional copy.

You will need to provide the following:

...Name of the groom

...Name of the bride at the time of the application

...Date of the marriage

...For those years prior to 1972, if you need this for Social Security as proof of age, you must also request a copy of the application.
